Family Reading Tips

A Mountain of New Words

Reading books furthers toddlers' language development and enriches their vocabulary. When reading, you can explain the meaning of new words or help toddlers understand them by pointing at the illustrations. After reading the book, you can connect it to real-life situations – "Remember when we were at the beach and made a huge mountain out of sand?"

All of Us Together

You can remind each other of things your toddlers did together with friends and family, such as playing in the backyard or making dinner, and then discuss them: What did you do? What did the others do? What was it like to do something all together?

Have you ever tried making a mountain at home? You can try building one from various materials – a mountain of laundry, a mountain of toys, a mountain of plastic kitchenware. Which of these mountains is the most stable?

Enriching our Vocabulary with Movement

The children in this book perform various actions such as digging and pouring sand from a bucket. You can try mimicking these actions while verbalizing what you are doing: "We are digging in the sand". You can also demonstrate these actions in the nearby playground or using kinetic sand at home.
