Family Reading Tips

Books are like well-loved and familiar friends. Getting to know a story by reading it over and over again, looking at the illustrations and familiarizing oneself with the characters, empowers toddlers and gives them confidence and generates enthusiasm. You should expose toddlers to new and different books, while going back and rereading their old favorites too.

Illustrations and New Words

The illustrations in this book present Eldad the Dwarf's ideas with no additional details. They help toddlers better understand the meaning of "spreading a tablecloth" or "parachuting". You can pause on each page, point at the illustrations together, and discuss – "What is the dwarf doing with the leaf now?"

You can also come up with new ideas, let your imaginations run wild, and have some fun; you can look for a nice big leaf, touch it and feel it, running free with any idea that comes to mind.
